- **Environmental Impact:** Extending an item's life by nine months reduces carbon, water, and waste footprints by around 20-30%.
- **Economic Development:** The estimated U.S. potential includes 35 million repairable items annually, \$2.0 billion in total labor revenue, and 27,000 living-wage jobs.
- Social Change: Builds community resilience and deepens customer trust.
